

ABBA 2022 NATIONAL TOURNAMENT – CHICAGO, IL

I hope everyone is excited about coming to Chicago this year for the 73rd Annual ABBA Tournament. The dates of the Tournament are May 26th thru May 29th. We will be staying at the Marriott Chicago O'Hara Hotel, 8535 West Higgins Road, Chicago, IL 60631. Phone # 1-800-228-9290 or 773-693-4444. Room rates are \$105.00 per night plus taxes (17.40%). When making Reservations make sure you mention that you are with American Blind Bowlers to receive group rate. Reservations must be received on or before May 4, 2022, to receive the discounted rates. Complimentary transportation is provided by the hotel to/from O'Hara International Airport. Brickyard Grill and Bar is located in the hotel for Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner. You can purchase discounted Breakfast vouchers for \$15.00 per day for the restaurant breakfast buffet when making reservations. The Hotel has

accessibility to Chicago Downtown thru the Chicago "L" 24-hour public transportation station just outside the parking lot. There are offsite restaurants within a mile of the hotel. Grocery store and convenient store within walking distance. Complimentary access to health club with room key and indoor and outdoor "swim through" pools and a whirlpool.

We will be bowling at Arlington Lanes, 3435 Kennicott Ave., Arlington Heights, IL 60004. Arlington Lanes will allow us to use our screw down rails this will be the last time we will be using the screw down rails as other bowling lanes do not allow us to use these rails. The lanes are providing food and drink specials for our group. While visiting the lanes we ate at the lounge and the food was great and prices were very reasonable.

The tournament packets will be e-mailed to the league secretaries on January 15th. The earlier you send the information in for the tournament I will be able to place you at the times you prefer to bowl. This will be based on how I receive the check and forms in the mail.
